To support families in Wales, The School Essentials Grant is provided by the Welsh Government to all children looked after, and to children in households with lower incomes. The grant provides financial assistance for essential school items to help ensure that children have access to the necessary resources for their education, such as uniforms, stationery, and other school essentials. For 2024-25, the scheme is providing £125 per learner for all year groups up to Year 11, and £200 for learners in Year 7. 



