News from Acting Head

We've had a great week completing activities to mark Online Safety Week and Anti-Bullying Week. The children have come up with some great ideas and enjoyed sharing ways they can help others. A few of the children did tell us that they use their mobile phones after bedtime without parents knowing and it's making it hard for them to sleep. We have shared how doing that can have a negative impact on their physical and mental health and we hope they won't be doing that anymore. We have many safeguarding tools on our IT equipment but we know that there are people constantly working out ways to bypass security and filtering systems. The children have been learning that they may experience things online that make them feel uncomfortable and if that happens, they must tell a safe adult immediately, but it is also a good idea for adults to check children's devices regularly.

Next week is Road Safety Week. The children have been collecting data on their travel trackers in class regularly to say how they travel to school. It would be lovely to see more children walking to school next week if this is possible.

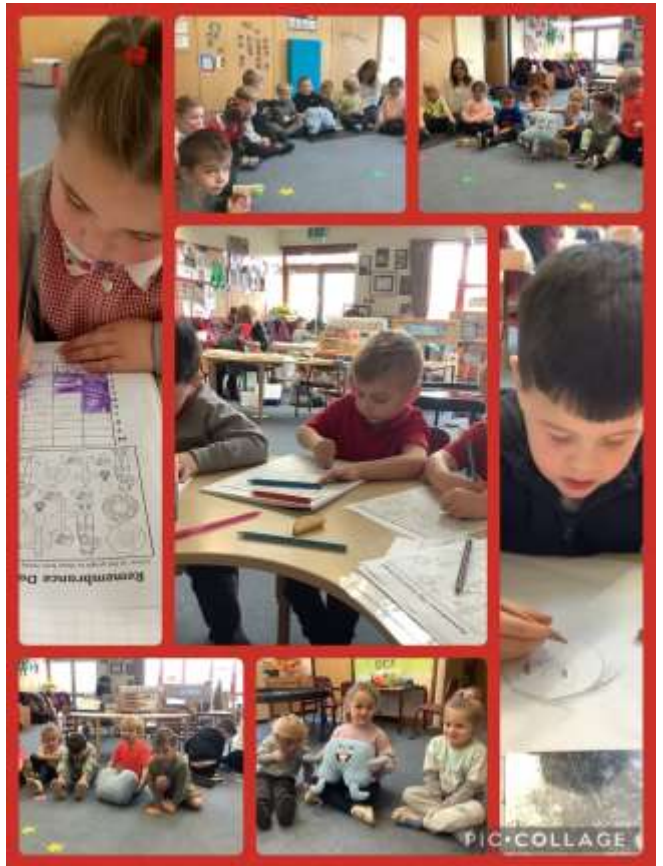

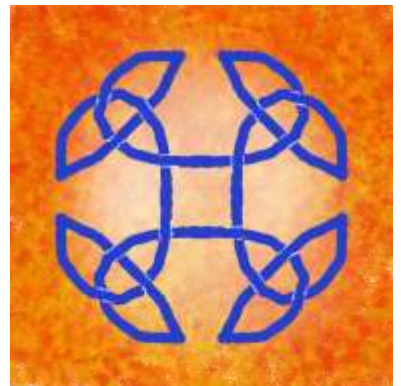
